
Reply to Manual Timeline Entries –Claims Connect

Reply to Manual Timeline Entries in Claims Connect

This job aid will guide a User through the steps to reply to manual timeline entries in Claims Connect.

Note: This document was created using a demo insurance company with generic settings. Keep in mind that your screens may appear slightly different. Please refer to your specific carrier guidelines for proper claim and estimate settings.

1. Within a Claim, navigate to the Timeline by clicking on the Timeline tab.



- 2. Choose Option A or B to initiate a **Reply** to a manual timeline entry:
 - a. Click the **Ellipsis menu** directly on the manual timeline entry and select **Reply** from the dropdown menu.









b. Click the manual timeline entry to open the entry's details blade and then click the new **Reply** button in the top right corner of the blade.







3. A **New Timeline Entry** blade will open from the right with the **To** parties pre-filled based on the original manual timeline entry.



4. Proceed to adjust and/or fill out the **Entry** sections, as with a normal Manual Timeline Entry.



5. Click **Add** to save the Reply Timeline Entry or **Cancel** to discard.
