## **Reordering Line Items in Mobile Claims**

This job aid will guide a User through the steps to reorder line items in a combined or merged view revision/supplement estimate, and to reorder line items in an estimate with subrooms when Estimate View Option 'Combine Related Subrooms' is ON.


The following tasks are described in this document:

**Note:** This document was created using a demo insurance company with generic settings. Keep in mind that your screens may appear slightly different. Please refer to your specific carrier guidelines for proper claim and estimate settings.

#### Reordering Line Items in a Combined or Merged View Revision Estimate


1. In a Revision/Supplement Estimate where additional line items have been added, navigate to the Estimate from the Claim Explorer.




2. Check the radio button next to **Combined** or **Merged** in the View options.




 Once in Merged or Combined view, scroll to the bottom of the estimate to view the newly added item(s), as newly added items to a Revision estimate will always default to being added to the bottom.




4. Click anywhere on the line item that needs relocating, then drag and drop it into the desired place.









**Note:** You may move multiple line items at once by checking the boxes of all the line items that you wish to move.



5. View the item(s) in its new location with the updated line item number(s).




**Note:** Line items may also be reordered in a Revision or Supplement Estimate from the Items Panel by clicking anywhere on the line item, then dragging and dropping into the desired order.




# Reordering Line Items in a Subroom Grouping when 'Combine Related Subrooms' is ON


- 1. Navigate to the Floorplan of a Claim where there is:
  - a. a subroom grouping AND
  - b. items have previously been added to all rooms of the subroom grouping



2. Locate the line item(s) to add to the estimate and drag & drop it onto the Floorplan. (For this specific update, the line item(s) can only be added to one or multiple rooms of the grouping that is not the main room.)




 Scroll down in the Items panel to see the newly added line items at the bottom of the list of items.




4. Next, navigate to the Estimate from the Claim Explorer.



5. Ensure that Combine Related Subrooms is ON in the Options within the View tab.




6. Scroll down in the Estimate to see the newly added items at the bottom of the Estimate. They are likely in a location that is not logical.




7. If moving multiple items, check the boxes next to the line items you wish to relocate.




8. Click anywhere on the line item(s) and drag & drop within the estimate to the desired new location. The red line is the indicator of where the items are to be placed.



9. View the line items in the new location with the updated line item numbers.



**Note:** Line items may also be reordered from the Items Panel when Combine Related Subrooms is ON by clicking anywhere on the line item or selected grouping of line items, then dragging and dropping into the desired order.
