Option to Apply Overhead and Profit to Taxes

This job aid will guide a user through the steps to apply overhead and profit to taxes at the claim level and/or at the estimate level in Mobile Claims. This only applies to taxes that are <u>not</u> set to be applied to overhead and profit.


The following tasks are described in this document:

- Configuring the Option to Apply Overhead and Profit to taxes at the Claim level
- Configuring the Option to Apply Overhead and Profit to taxes at the Estimate level

Note: This document was created using a demo insurance company with generic settings. Keep in mind that your screens may appear slightly different. Please refer to your specific carrier guidelines for proper claim and estimate settings.

Configuring the Option to Apply Overhead and Profit to taxes at the Claim level


1. Within a claim from the Loss Summary screen, click **Configure claim options** from the General tab.



2. From the General tab of the Default Estimate Totals Page Layout, go to the **Overhead** and **Profit** section.




3. Check the box next to **Apply overhead and profit to taxes**. This will apply the setting to all newly created estimates.



Note: It is possible that depending on company-configured default settings, this box may appear checked already upon opening. Unchecking the box will turn the setting off for the claim.

The column with Contents estimate options will only appear if a company has Contents Estimating enabled.

4. To apply this setting to all newly created and existing estimates, check the box next to **Apply to all existing estimates**.




5. Click the red **X** to close the box and save the settings changes.



Configuring the Option to Apply Overhead and Profit to taxes at the Estimate level


1. Navigate to the Estimate Totals page.




2. Click on Configure Totals Page Layout.



3. From the General tab of the Totals Page Layout dialog box, go to the **Overhead and Profit** section.




4. Check the box next to **Apply overhead and profit to taxes** to turn this setting on.

5. Click **OK** to save the updated settings.
